

## **Golden Heron 2009 for Zuiderzee Museum**

**The Zuiderzee Museum in Enkhuizen has won a Golden Heron in the category *Occasional Projects*. The Museum received this award for its contribution to the museum night of 2008 in the form of a creation by Arnout Hulskamp.**

During the event in Amsterdam, a life-size representation of a fruit machine was projected on the canalside houses from a museum object on the water. By pressing a button, people in the audience could mix the digital collection consisting of historical and contemporary objects from our collection.

The Zuiderzee Museum was also among the winners in 2007 in the category *Spatial Media* with the project *Help the Curator*, made by TWV Media.
