Easter egg treasure hunt during opening weekend on 4 and 5 April

The summer season in the park of the Zuiderzee Museum in Enkhuizen begins on 2 April. On that date, the park will once again move into top gear. Historical buildings will open, craftspeople will demonstrate skills from bygone days on the Zuiderzee, and a number of premises will display present-day work based upon traditional crafts. The museum park is again accessible by ferry.

Those who solve the puzzle with the letters on the large Easter eggs will receive a pleasant surprise as a reward. During the winter season, the technical service department has implemented several large-scale renovations in the museum park, with the aid of various external contractors. Several bridges and facings have been completely renewed. The toilet facilities have been modernized.

The Zuiderzee Museum is open daily from 10.00 to 17.00. The parking lot is situated next to the entrance pavilion (Zijlweg 1). This is also the pick-up point for the ferry.
