

Pimp your shirt in the Zuiderzee Museum Enkhuizen

Are you creative? If so, you should visit the Zuiderzee Museum in Enkhuizen between 25 April and 5 May 2009 and do your thing. During the *Pimp your Shirt* activities, you can make a spectacular item of clothing from a white shirt. Or would you rather have something on the wall? You can make your own work of art and allow your imagination free rein.

You can design your own T-shirt in the hobby attic in the Museum Park, just like a real fashion designer. For this, you are given a shirt that you can *pimp* with all kinds of materials, such as buttons, pieces of fabric and wool. You can take inspiration from the *Gone with the Wind* fashion show that is on show in the Museum and the Museum Park. Or you can make your own painting in the style of the fashion show or of the Zuiderzee Museum. Each activity costs 2.50 Euro.

More activities

During the May vacation, there are many more activities on offer: dressing up in traditional costume, walking on clogs and playing old Dutch games. Do you prefer to work with less refined tools? If so, you can make a clog boat complete with a sail and rudder. Energy for still more? Then you can sail through the canals of the Museum Park or learn to write with a dip pen and ink in the local school. For the sweet-toothed among you, there is old fashioned confectionery on sale, such as syrup croutons and liquorice.
